- Snacks will be provided to the students by the school.
- Parents will only be able to collect their child after their complete performance and upon signing a form from the teacher or staff in charge.
- The school will be responsible for taking photographs and recording videos. We respectfully urge that parents refrain from approaching participants during performances to snap photographs.
- **Stage blocking and final rehearsals** will take place on Friday, November 17, 2023. Practices are currently ongoing during the zero period.
- We are committed to ensuring a successful event for all attendees hence, we request everyone to strictly adhere to school rules and guidelines during the event.
