2. First School Entry Requirements and Precautionary Measures

- A. PCR Test
 - A 96-hour valid PCR Test is required for students aged 12+ ONLY to enter the campus. The students can avail of a free PCR test at any clinic, hospital or drive-through test centre. Requirement: Emirates ID or passport if Emirates ID has not yet been issued. Please send the negative PCR test result by email to clinic.eis@eisalain.com
 - **Required for those who have Covid-19 symptoms** so they can return to in-class education after presenting a negative PCR test result and clearance of fever.
 - For parents and visitors, a green pass status on Al Hosn must be presented to the guard on duty to access the premises.
- B. **Masks are only required indoors**. However, <u>removal of the same indoors</u> will be allowed only for the following:
 - Students in KG
 - Students participating in sports and performing arts
 - Students of Determination with a doctor's note confirming that student cannot wear a mask.
- C. **Distance Learning** will be offered only for the following cases:
 - Positive Covid-19 test result
 - Exhibits symptoms; parent must provide sick leave letter from HAAD

5. Drop Off and Pick Up

Students using their transport are expected to be punctual for their classes. All Grade 1 to 7 students (bus and own transport) must be in school at 7:45 AM for the morning assembly or circle time. Students are considered late if they arrive beyond 8 AM and absent if the 1st class period is missed.

KG students are expected to be in school throughout the day from 8:45 AM until 12:55 PM. Please be mindful of the staggering dismissal.

Remember that students (own transport) should not be on-campus unsupervised before or after school timings. They should not arrive earlier than 7:30 AM or be picked up later than 2:30 PM. The school will not be responsible for any untoward incident because of parents dropping off/ picking up their ward before or beyond the times mentioned.

Over the coming term, we will undertake a cycle of focused evaluation to clarify plans. As we take the school forward, we will recognize strengths and address areas where the school needs to improve. As part of this process, we will ask for parents' feedback through periodic online surveys and specific focus group discussions.

6. Other Key Procedures and Processes

- No money should be handed over to the bus staff or the class teacher. Any cash payments should be made only at the front office.
- The school office should be informed immediately of any change of address, telephone number and emergency contact number to keep the school database updated. An email to <u>sa@eisalain.com</u> can be sent.
- For any leave exceeding three (3) days, please seek prior permission from our principal. For any
 medical leave, please send a doctor's certificate by email to the clinic or student affairs. Important:
 Any leave/absence that is NOT informed or notified to the school will be considered unexcused.
- Please ensure that all school accounts are up-to-date and no fee dues are pending.
