School - Parent Communication

Consistently improving communication between parents and educators at EIS is more than just a goal. It's a practice that we live out daily. The school recognizes the importance of open and two-way communication. We ensure that our parents can speak with us and that the staff are always on hand to answer questions or give support.

One concern put across to the school recently has been "How is it possible that teachers teaching in primary school are teaching the secondary level?" The leadership team and management would like to assure you that though most of our teachers who enjoined EIS handled primary education in ZPS, they were qualified, duly recognized and approved by ADEK to teach higher grades. It is important to note that ZPS – British runs until Grade 6. There are some subjects that need specialist educators and our HR department has an ongoing hiring process to secure these teachers for the next academic year.

Only teachers with approval from the Ministry can exercise their teaching profession.

In addition, we put attention on continuing professional development to keep our teachers abreast of new knowledge and practices in the field, including those of evaluation and assessment to help them gauge individual student learning and adapt activities according to student needs.

EIS is over and above just academia. Your child's emotional development and social needs are as important as their academic growth.
