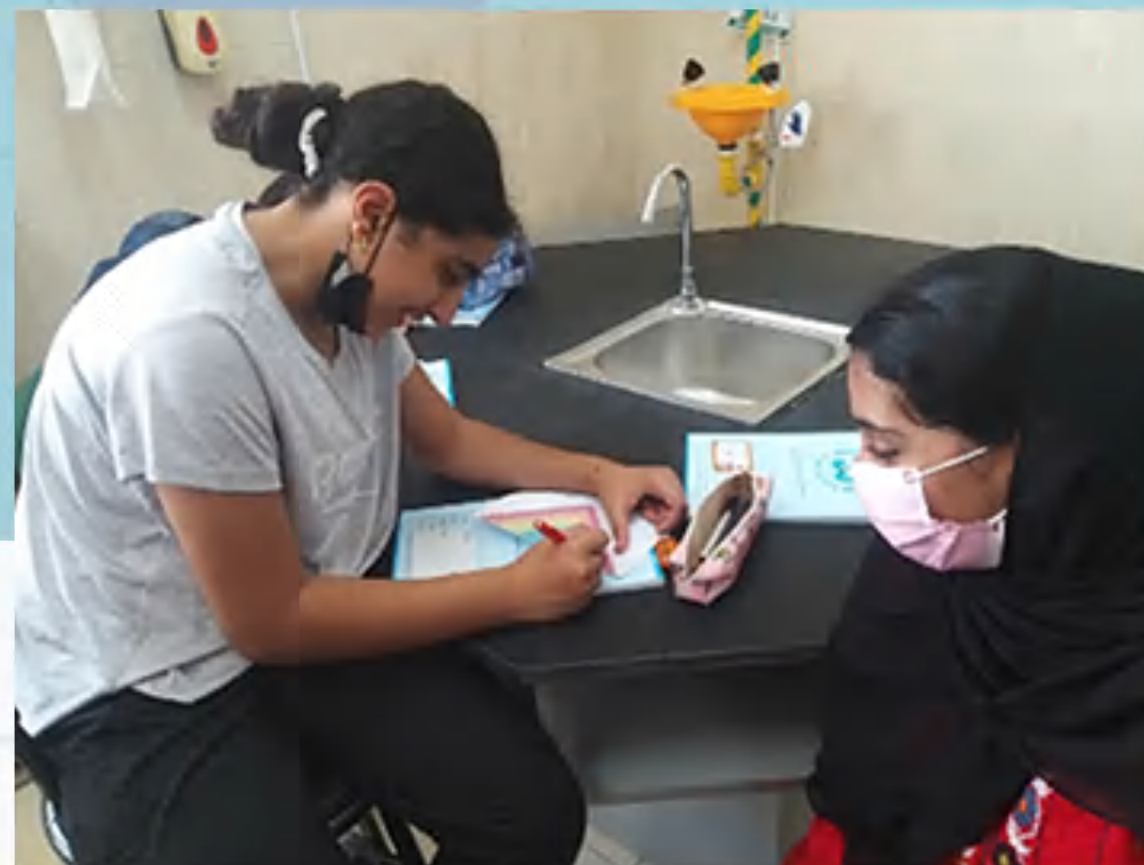
Grade 7B Students exploring their scientific skills of experimenting, predicting, investigating, analysing and concluding.

You must be thinking, "How can friends share experiences if they don't have different interests?" Well, friends sharing different interests can be annoyed by people talking about things they don't know about.

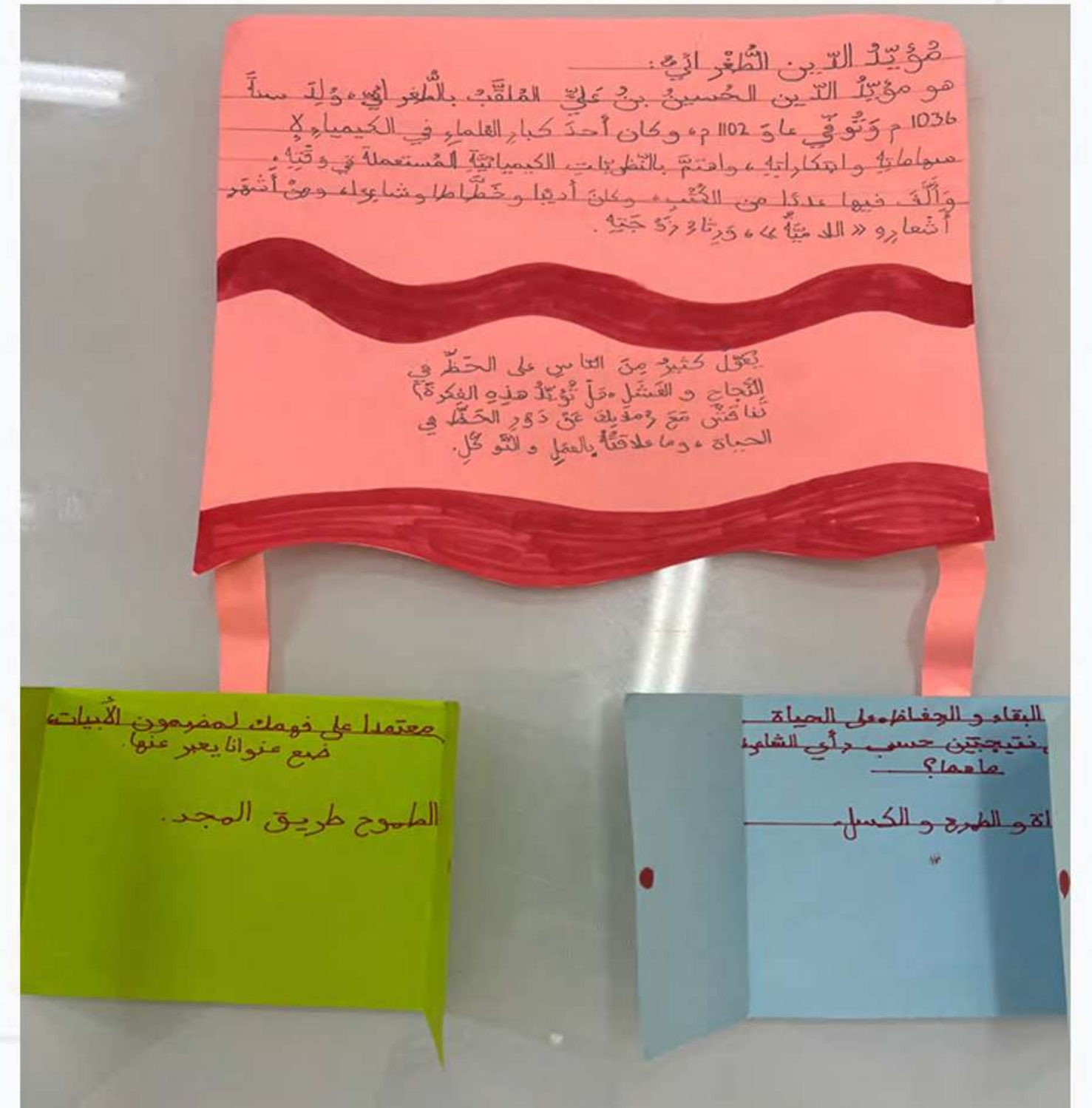
In conclusion, friends should share similar interests to be able to get along with each other and make their friendship last longer.

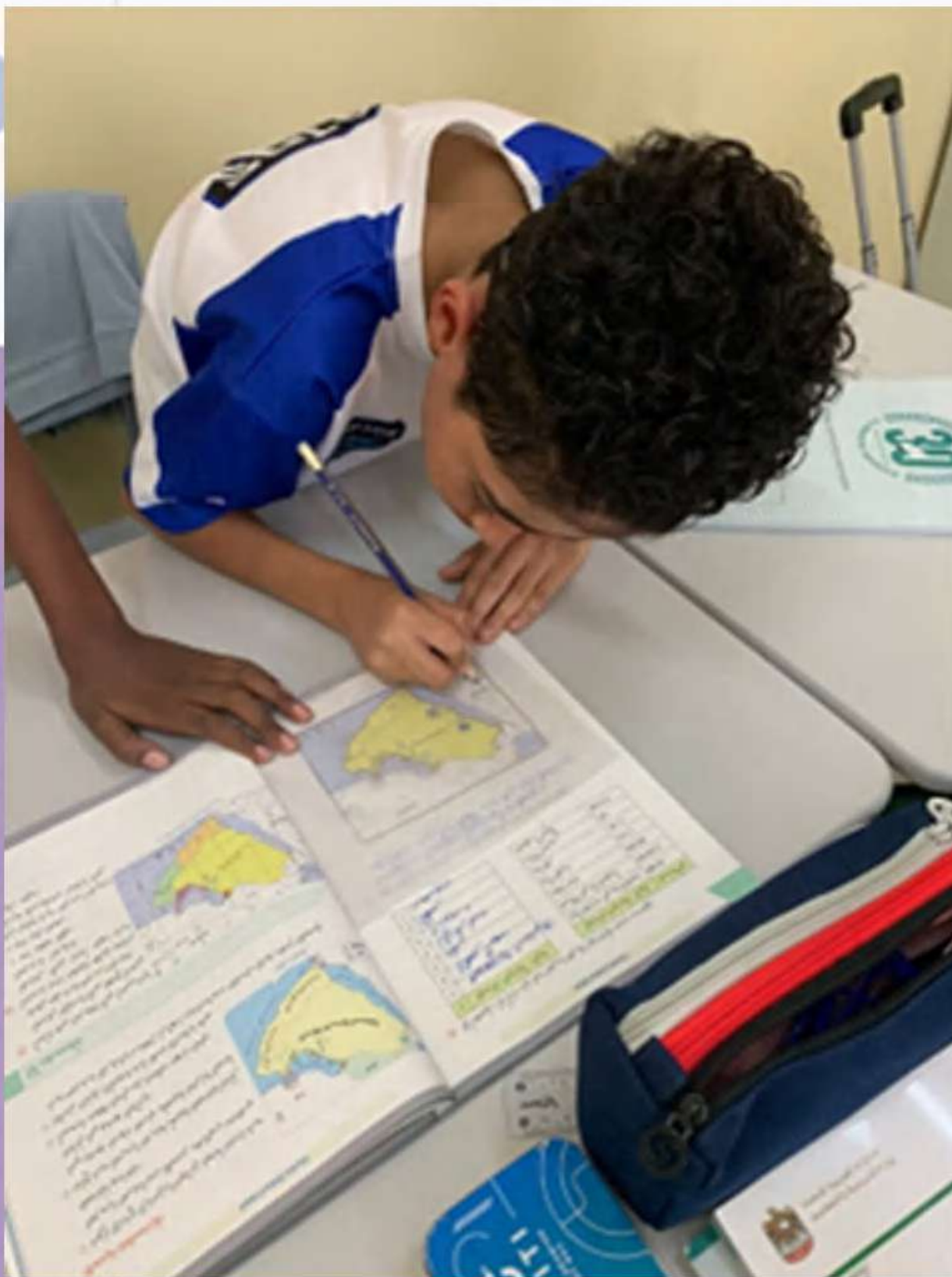
