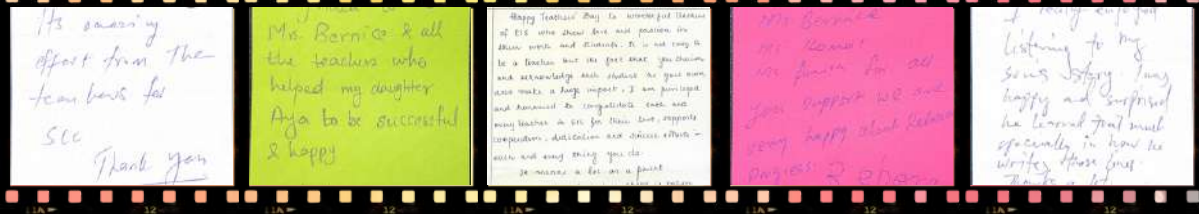
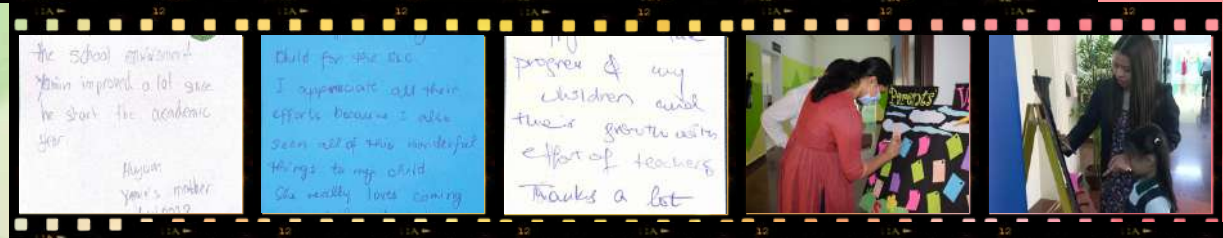
Students displayed lots of hands-on activities, narrated stories using 'Story Boxes', said poems & rhymes, and confidently described their work in the 'Portfolios'!

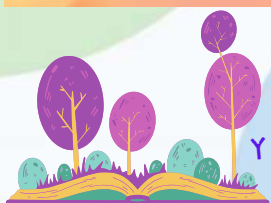

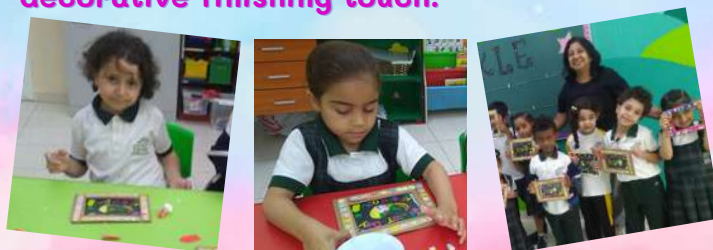

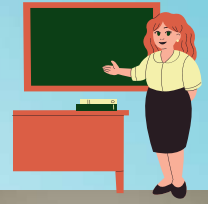
Parents were extremely delighted to attend the 'phonics session' as they learned how children learn indoors and outdoors. They were happy being engaged in classes with the students and praised everyone!

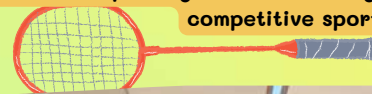
