We cordially invite you to attend the first EIS' Sports Day, "Brilliance Unchallenged", on the 27th of January 2023, Friday (afternoon) from 5 PM – 8 PM on the EIS grounds. The students have rigorously prepared for their brilliant performances on the Sports Day. The children will compete in various sporting activities such as relay, track races, shot put, long jump, etc. We are grateful for your contribution and support to the school's continuous effort to encourage a healthy and active lifestyle for our students.

Kindly take note of the following:

1. SPORTS DAY GUIDELINES

- There will be **NO morning classes on the 27th of January**; however, **ALL students** (bus and own transport) **must report to school by 4 PM**. **KG students** can come with their parents **at 5 PM**.
- Students must come to school wearing the **dress code** according to their groups below:

GROUPS	DRESS CODE
KG – GRADE 2	- Drill Students will wear their tracksuits (3-piece attire). These tracksuits will be distributed on Thursday, 26.01.2023
GRADE 3 -7	- Complete PE Uniform (representing their House Colours) then change to tracksuits for the drills display. Tracksuits will be given to these students on Friday, 27.01.2023 (evening) .
STUDENT COUNCIL	- Regular School Uniform with Blazer for girls: <i>white hair accessories, the prescribed 'green hijab' or scarf</i> both boys & girls: <i>white (sports) rubber shoes</i> Bring their PE uniform for the sporting events/ march past.
SCOUTS	- Selected Scout Members for the Guard of Honor parade to wear their Scouts Uniform . Bring their PE uniform for the sporting events/ march past.
STUDENTS OF GRADE 2 & 3 (ADEK CUP)	- Students who represented our school in the ADEK Cup interschool competition must wear their football attire with white socks. Bring their PE uniform for the sporting events.

- School transport will be provided to the bus children (only pick-up). You will be informed of your child's pick-up timings. No drop-off service after the event.
- Parents shall hand over their children to the class teachers upon arrival. Children must be picked up immediately after their performances.
- The school will provide snacks for the students.
- Water and juices will be available for sale at the canteen.
- We humbly ask our parents to refrain from taking photographs or videos, which might come in the way of others viewing the show, as the school has arranged for a professional photographer to take pictures and videos.

- Parents must not allow their younger children to cross the tracks while the events are happening, as this can be dangerous.

The details of the dress codes for individual groups will also be shared on MS Teams by the class teacher.
