KINDERGARTEN	<p>100th Day Customized Costume</p> <p>To celebrate the completion of 100 days of kindergarten, students will come to school wearing a customized costume (DIY). The shirt must have 100 objects attached to it, along with a phrase. The objects can be anything readily available in your home, such as buttons, pompoms, stickers, lightweight toys, etc.</p>
GRADES 1 - 7	<p>Interclass Competition</p> <p>100 Word Challenge - to demonstrate the class' mastery over vocabulary and grammar.</p> <p>Scavenger Hunt – each class must search for all hidden objects in a series of locations in the school. They must find all the items in the shortest time possible to win.</p> <p>100-Objects Pyramid Building – the class will build the tallest or strongest tower or pyramid using any 100-piece object. They have to work, collaborate and problem-solve with their peers.</p>
