The magnitude 7.8 earthquake rocked Turkey and Syria early on Feb. 6 when most people were asleep, collapsing residential buildings and putting the countries into crisis. As reported, this quake is one of the strongest to hit the region in the past 100 years. The search and rescue operations for survivors continue amid harsh winter conditions.

Our hearts and thoughts are with the children and families affected, especially those who have lost loved ones or who have been injured. The immediate priority is for families, especially children receive the support they so desperately need.

Therefore, let us come forward with the best of our capacities to extend our help. As we lift them in prayers to the Almighty, let our compassion, empathy and generosity be felt tangibly.

EIS is initiating a drive **to collect aid in kind** in support of the UAE's Red Crescent efforts to mobilise humanitarian relief supplies for quake-ravaged Turkey and Syria. Your immediate voluntary donations will help the affected families in these countries.
