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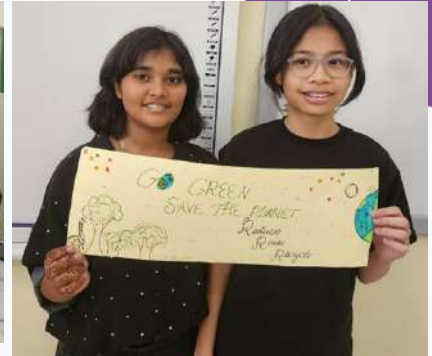

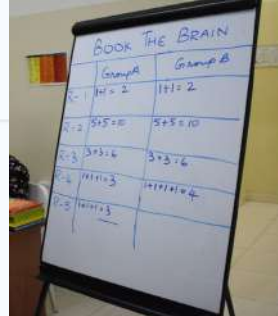
THE 5 PILLARS OF ISLAM - Students during the assembly shared the importance of Islam and explained the 5 Pillars of Islam.



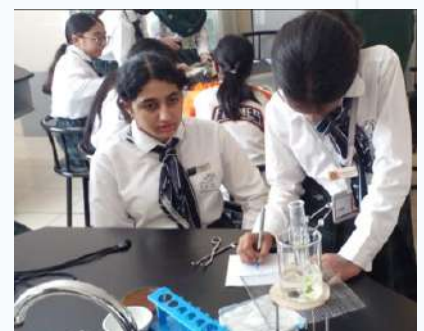
ISLAMIC WEEK (Last 10 days of Ramadan) - Students during the assembly emphasized the reason behind the importance of last 10 days of Ramadan.

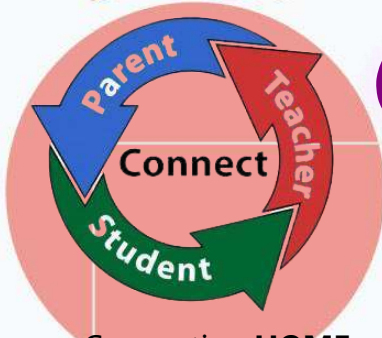


BABY WATCH SESSION

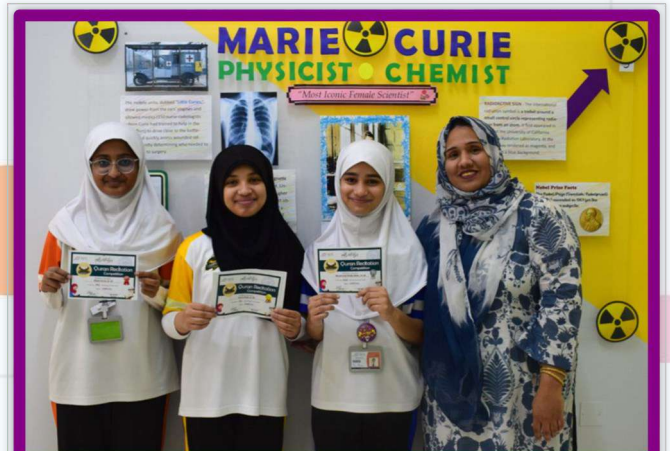

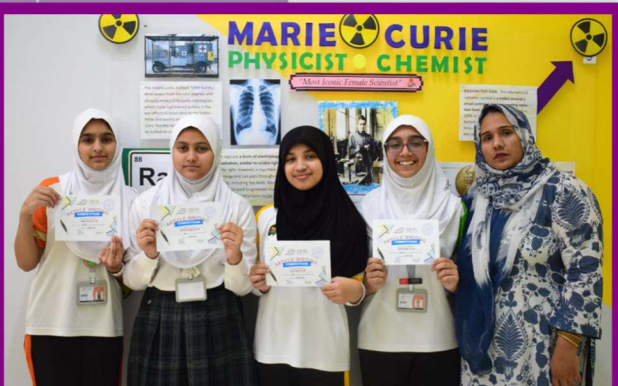

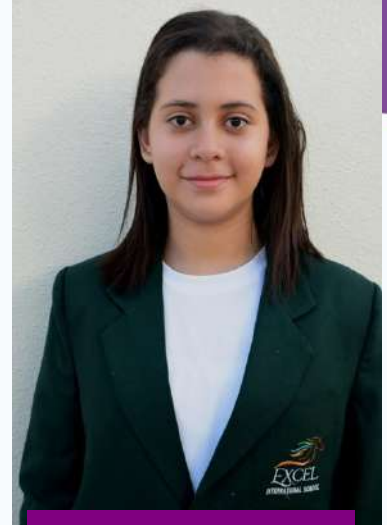
