Students of grade 5 comprehended the aspect of how blood is composed of, by observing the cells under a microscope – the many components like Plasma, RBC and Platelets.



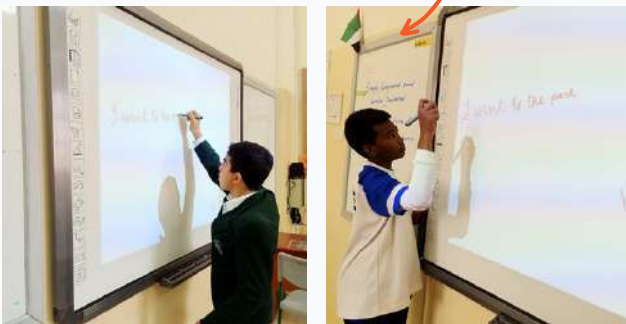
CLASS ACTIVITIES

Our grade 5 techies, multitasking during different sessions; with BYOD Day being one of the most awaited days where they learn with much eagerness.



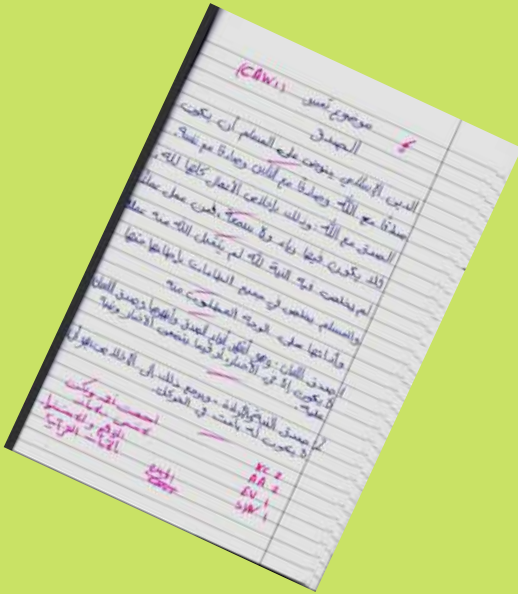
