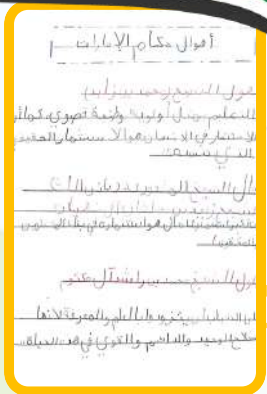
# SALAM SYLVANIA: EMBRACING DIVERSITY AT EIS

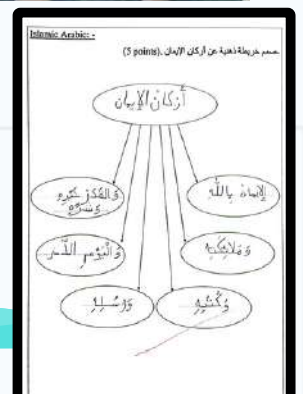
