Precise folding skills are mastered by the students, who produce adorable origami dragonflies with artistic grace and skill.



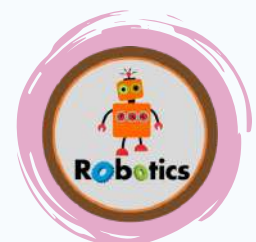
Grade 5 to 8 used visuals and narratives, they showcased images of various personalities, shedding light on their stories and significance in a captivating media production.

As a creative project, students create a colourful Handprint Blossom Tree as a testament to their dedication to sustainability and environmental stewardship.



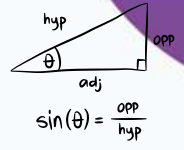
As they prepare delicious Easy Shortbread Biscuits, students experience the joy of baking and transform their love of food into a joyful activity.
