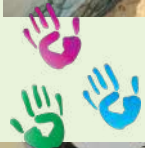




Human Growth ~Chart


