Excel International School in the UAE commemorates Emirati Children's Day, emphasising the significance of youth and culture while promoting solidarity and instilling a sense of pride among children.

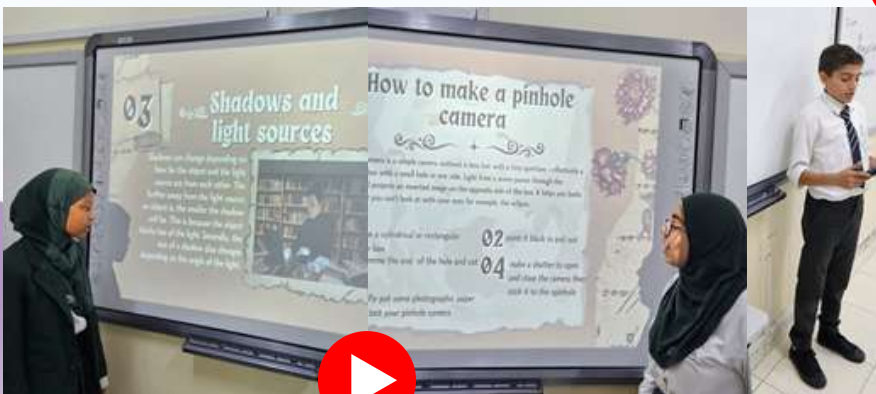


Fun Learning with Classroom Activities



Students actively involved in mathematical problem-solving, with an emphasis on determining the area of various shapes. They utilise their comprehension of mathematical principles in practical tasks, including the computation of the volume of a cube.

Engaging in project-based learning, students dive deep into displacement reaction concepts, fostering hands-on understanding.

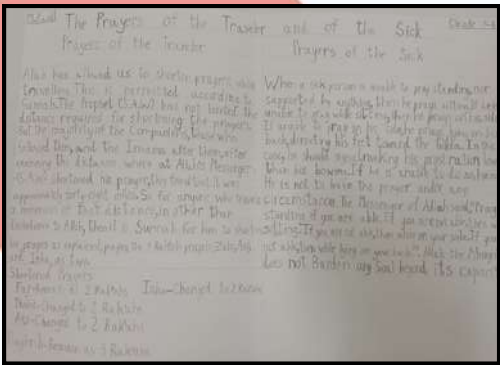
Exploring and preparing the distillation set, ensuring everything is in order for the imminent experiment



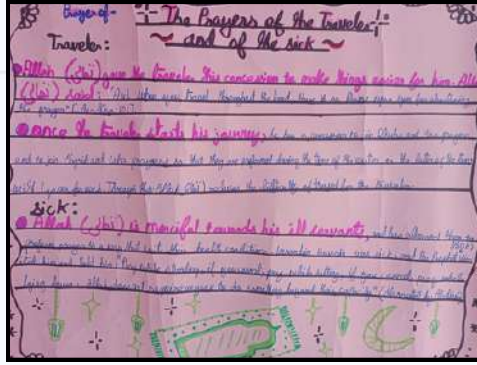
The students explore squishy circuits with playdough, investigating conductivity and electricity flow.

“PBL” students took responsibility of their learning. Dissected a flower to gain understanding of its anatomy and its role in reproduction.

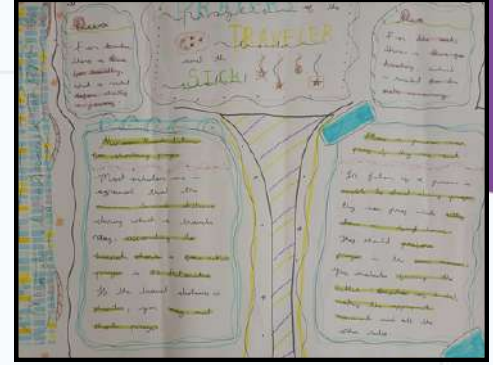




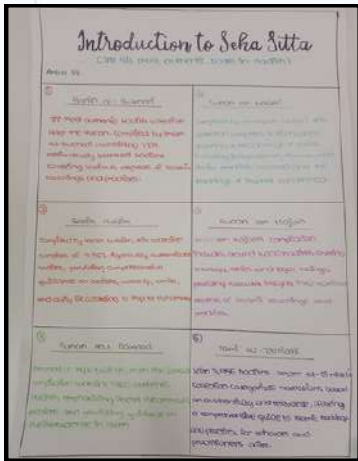

How are you? How is your family doing? I hope you all are doing well. I want to share with you details of something I bought and unfortunately, it is defective. So, I want your help to find a solution.

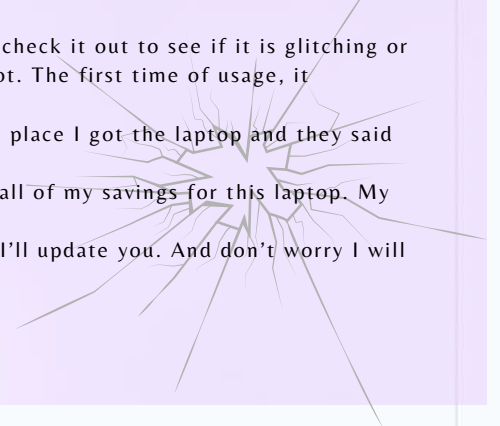

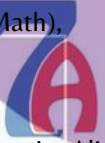

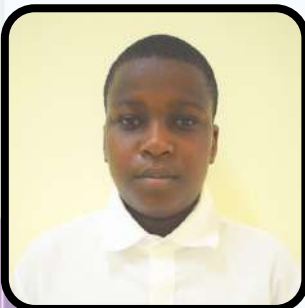
International Women's Day

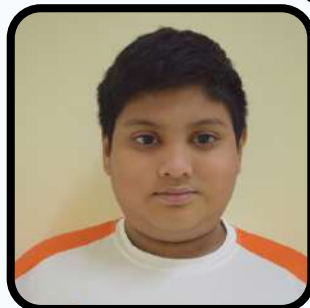


