Honoring Outstanding Achievements Across Academics and Beyond



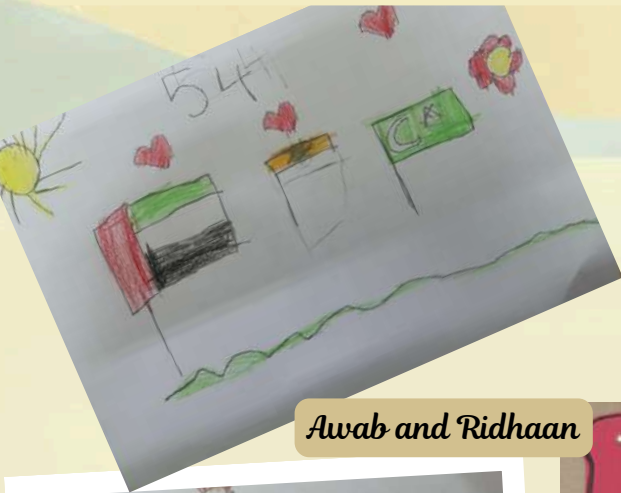

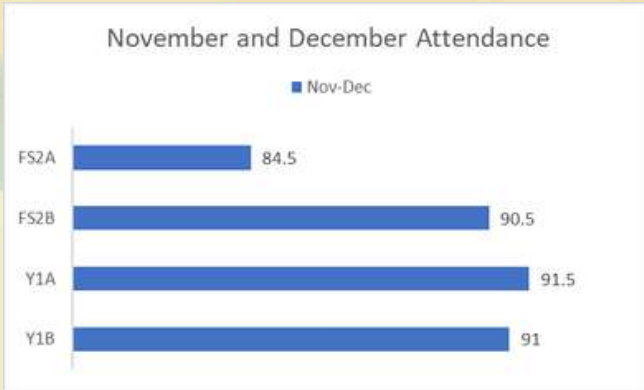
I am Ms. Yasmin Abdrabou Ahmed – School Social Worker
