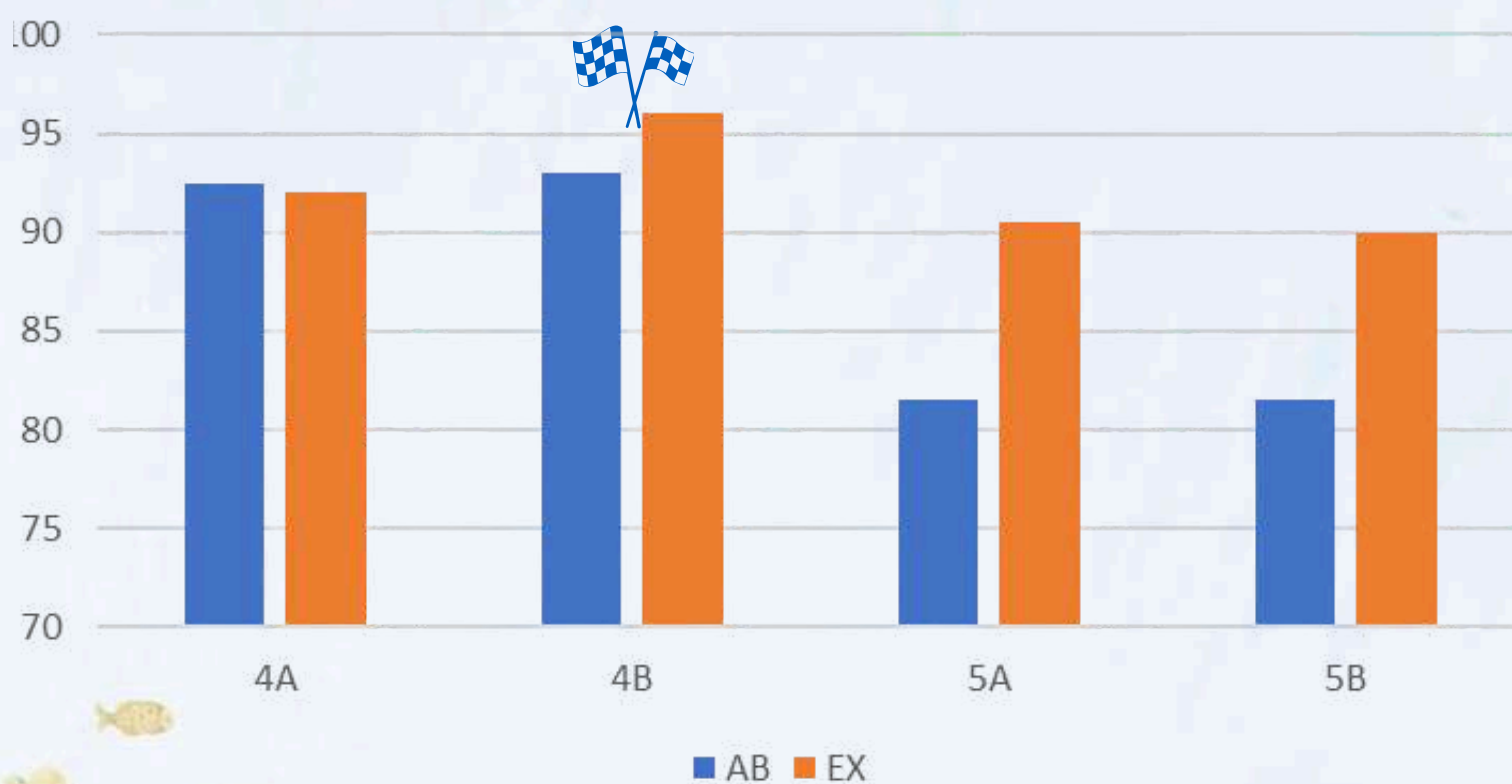
Inclusion at Excel: A Note from the Head of Inclusion
